



**You helped 21,000 people find hope —
and over 3,000 came to Christ!**

I want to tell you what your generosity did this year. You made a difference in real, tangible lives.

Because of you, more than **21,000** people walked into a trauma recovery workshop carrying pain, grief, anger, or heartache, and they walked out with hope, healing, and forgiveness. These are men, women, and children from the persecuted church and the communities around them. You didn't just fund a program. **You helped carry someone's grief.**

And more than **3,000** of them didn't just find healing from human suffering; they found healing in Jesus. Three thousand people came to Christ this year, in the middle of their pain, because you made a way for someone to sit with them in it. That's not a statistic to us. That's 3,000 new names written in the Book of Life, **and you had a hand in everyone.**

You also stood behind our team of more than 20 country coordinators, trainers, and global mentors, who delivered an average of 80 workshops and art therapy sessions every month across five countries. And you stood behind our intercessors here in Australia and overseas, who meet monthly to pray for this work, for our teams, and for the people we serve.

None of that happens without you.



I've been praying about our teams and our budget for this new financial year, and John 21:15–17 keeps coming to mind. Jesus asks Peter, "Do you love me? Then feed my sheep." That's what sets this work apart. Others meet physical needs, and that matters. But you are helping meet mental, emotional, and spiritual hunger. You're part of someone's restoration story, the same restoration Peter needed, and the same restoration many of our participants are now walking through themselves. And here's the beautiful part: the people you've helped restore are now turning around and feeding others, not with resources, but with forgiveness, mercy, and love, and now, for over 3,000 of them, the gospel itself. Your generosity is multiplying itself through them.

Wherever our teams go, people say thank you. I want you to know: that thank you is meant for you too.

And because of you, we reached it!

On the very last day of June, your generosity and prayer carried us across our \$100,000 EOFY goal. Some of you are even increasing your monthly giving for this new year, choosing to sacrifice more for brothers and sisters you may never meet.

One of our givers said something to me recently that I haven't stopped thinking about: *"It's God who deserves all the thanks and glory. I was just the channel God worked through."* I can't think of a better way to describe what you do. You are a channel, and God has used you to bless people who are hurting, halfway around the world, and to bring over 3,000 of them home to Him.

So thank you, our brothers and sisters. And thank You, Lord, for working through your people.
